This past weekend, at the Tour De Lion in central New Jersey, TMC-WV bicycle racing team earned several first place victories as well as many other notable finishes.

Trade Manage Racing – Westwood Velo is a nationally recognized cycling team which has won several National and State championships in road, mountain and cyclo-cross disciplines. This past weekend, TMC-WV participated in an early-season race series at Branchbrook Park in Newark, New Jersey. There were over 280 competitors in several races from various parts of the Northeast. The Teams’ results were quite significant.

In the Masters category, TMC-WV’s Troy Kimball, took first place by attacking a breakaway group, using his fast finishing speed to earn the hard-fought victory. Troy is a previous member of the NORBA Masters Mountain Bike World Championship Team, previously ranked #1 in the nation for USCF Masters racing, and Race Director for TMC-WV. TMC-WV’s Roger Aspholm, 2002 Norba Mountain Bike National Champion, 2003 NJ Time Trial Champion and 2004 Masters Road Race Champion, took 2nd place behind Troy, giving the Team a one-two sweep of the hotly contested race.

In Category 3 racing, TMC-WV’s Kenneth Lundgren and Mike Gisler attacked the main field early, and then worked together to finish first and second, respectively. This was an impressive show of teamwork and strength.

In Category 4 racing, TMC-WV’s expanded squad worked hard to keep the race together for sprinter John Raheb, who exploded in the final 500 meters to earn a well deserved second place. In Cat 5 racing, Greg McGinley took top honors out-sprinting the field in a hectic, fast finish.
