Trade Manage Racing – Results Update

May 10, 2006 – Saddle Brook, New Jersey – Trade Manage Racing, a nationally recognized bicycle racing team, competing in road, mountain bike and cyclocross disciplines, continues to generate winning results in its 2006 campaign.. Over the past several weeks, Trade Manage Racing competed in over a dozen events throughout the Northeast, many offering national exposure and wide ranging success for the team and its sponsors. The Team is comprised of many State and National champions in the various disciplines.

- ❑ Ghostrider Tour - March 25, 2006: This race was week four of the five week series event and the turnout was spectacular. With almost 225 competitors, all of the fields were well represented. In the Masters 35+ category, TMC-WV's Roger Aspholm continued his winning streak with another 1st place victory. In the Pro / 123 category, Ed Ceccolini finished 8th in this highly competitive category. Eric Perkins earned a 2nd place in his category.
- ❑ Johnny Cakes Series – April 1, 2006: The series completed with TMC-WV's Steve Goldman and Jon Raheb tied for 3rd in the points series, each having won a individual races during the 3 week competition. Additionally, Chris Chapman placed 5th in the points series, giving TMC-WV three of the top five spots on the overall series.
- ❑ Sandy Hook TT:- April 1, 2006: Michael Gisler tackled the Pro 1,2 Men's division with a strong second place win. Additionally, Robert Malovany came in 3rd place in the Masters Category.
- ❑ Tour de Lamb – April 2, 2006: The TMC-WV team did a good job of shutting down the field in this race even though they were tired from the time trial the day before. Troy Kimball was able to pull out a 1st place win in the Pro / 123 category; Greg Keller took the win in his category.
- ❑ Brandywine Duathlon – April 9, 2006: Espen Kateraas proudly represented TMC-WV, winning 1st place in the Male 35 – 39 Category in this hotly contested event. These results qualify him for the US National Duathlon Team and an entry into the World Duathlon Championships later in the year.
- ❑ Readington Time Trial – April 9, 2006: TMC-WV had several strong finishes at this event with Roger Aspholm taking 1st place in the Pro / 123 Category with Troy Kimball coming in 4th and Michael Gisler following in 5th place. Steve Goldman took first in his Category with Greg Keller following in 4th place. Additionally, Robert Malovany took 2nd place in the Masters grouping, and Kevin Hazucha took 3rd in his category.
- ❑ Battenkill Roubaix – April 15, 2006: In a long, epic back country race in gorgeous Salem, NY, TMC-WV's Michael Gisler won his grouping with a blistering attack on the final run into town. Steve Goldman battled hard for an 8th place in his field.
- ❑ Sturbridge Road Race - April 29, 2006: As a national rankings race, Sturbridge-Palmer is one of the top five races on the east coast. TMC-WV competed in the nationally ranked race which took place in Fiskdale, MA. Roger Aspholm had a triumphant 1st place win in the Master 30+ category with Troy Kimball coming in at 5th place. Additionally, Steve Goldman came in 12th place behind some of the east coast's strong competition.

- ❑ Palmer Liberty Road Race - April 30, 2006 – For the second day in a row, Roger Aspholm won 1st place in the Masters 35+ category proving his skills as one of the east coast’s strongest riders. Troy Kimball finished 8th in this category as well. This was the second day of strong showings for the team on a national level.
- ❑ Jiminy Peak Road Race – May 6,2006: The Shaun Thornton Memorial Jiminy Peak Road Race was held in Hancock MA and once again, TMC-WV made a great showing. In the Masters 35+ category, Troy Kimball fought to come in 2nd place despite being sick all week long, while Roger Aspholm took 9th place in this very competitive category. In the tough Category 4 race Steve Goldman came in a bike length behind the winner, taking 9th place, his 8th top ten of the year.
- ❑ High Point Hill Climb – May 6, 2006 – This race was held in Montague NJ and TMC-WV made great strides here with Bob Kaplan coming in 1st in the Category 55+ and Robert Malovany following up in 5th place. Additionally, in the Pro 123 category Mike Gisler came in 2nd, with Ken Lundgren coming in 5th.
- ❑ Colts Neck – May 7,2006 – Not a long race, but a very hard and fast race was fought through by using a great display of teamwork. The result was Dave Junius coming in 2nd and Steve Goldman following closely behind in 3rd. It is this kind of teamwork that continues to be TMC-WV winning results.
