- ❑ Balloon Festival Classic, June 10, 2006 – New teammate Will Riffelmacher dominated the Men’s Category 3/4 coming in 1<sup>st</sup> place in this event held in Cambridge, NY. Roger Aspholm won the Men’s 35 / 45, with Troy Kimball closely behind in 5<sup>th</sup> place.
- ❑ Tour of High Bridge, June 11, 2006 – TMC Racing dominated this tough 3.3-mile circuit event that is definitely not for the faint of heart. Chris Chapman won in Category 4 with a devastating sprint in the final lap. Mike Gisler came in 2<sup>nd</sup> place in the tough Category 3. Roger Aspholm took home 3<sup>rd</sup> place in the Masters 35+ division, right behind two professional level riders.
- ❑ NJ State Time Trial Championship, June 4, 2006 – TMC Racing dominated much of the podium. In the 40K distance category, Roger Aspholm won Pro 123 State Championship, with Mike Gisler following in 4<sup>th</sup> and Ed Ceccolini in 5<sup>th</sup> place. In the Men’s 30+ Category, Bill O’Donnell finished with a strong 1<sup>st</sup> place win. Steve Goldman, CEO of Trade Manage, won the State Championship in the Men’s 35+ category, with Eric Streckfuss just behind him in 3<sup>rd</sup> place. The Men’s 40+ brought Troy Kimball in 2<sup>nd</sup> place, while in the Men’s 45+ Steven Fairchild finished in 7<sup>th</sup> place. Completing the Team’s dominance of this event, Robert Malovany won 1<sup>st</sup> place in the Men’s 50+ Category. A great day for the entire team with the squad walking away with four New Jersey State Champions.
- ❑ Flanders Time Trial, May 13, 2006 – This event, a 20km hilly presented by Somerset Wheelmen in Flanders, NJ gave Mike Gisler a strong 1<sup>st</sup> place win in Category 123, setting a new course record. Ken Lundgren following closely behind in 4<sup>th</sup> place. In Category 35+, Steve Goldman took first place while Bob Kaplan won Category 55+ again proving his dominance in this group.
- ❑ Bear Mountain Classic, May 14, 2006 – On an overcast and slightly chilly day, exhibiting incredible strength and endurance, Roger Aspholm took 3<sup>rd</sup> place in the nearly 100 mile Pro 123 Category. In the Men’s Category 4 grouping, Steve Goldman launched a much-talked about 2 ½ lap solo break, getting caught in the last kilometers of the race, but hung on for a 8<sup>th</sup> place finish.
- ❑ Corner House, Princeton NJ – New addition to our team, Will Riffelmacher won the Pro 123 category, in his first Pro 123 race, breaking away early and keeping the main field at bay.
